#### 1. 表示命令，语气强硬的祈使句，句末用降调

Don't open the door. ↘ 不准开门。

Don't be stupid. ↘ 不准犯傻。

#### 2. 表示鼓励，态度亲切或客气的请求的祈使句，句末用升调。

Don't worry about that. ↗ 别担心。

Let's do it together. ↗ 让我们一起做吧。

#### 3. 表示恳切地请求，或责备或表示关心的急切警告时用降升调，第一个重读音节用降调，句末用升调。

Don't ↘ open the door. ↗ 别开门。（天气冷的）

Don't ↘ eat so much cheese. ↗ 别吃这么多奶酪。（太多奶酪对身体不好）
